I. Follow the Leader — Every Great Leader is a Follower

We pick up Jesus' cross

Galatians 2:20 (NIV) 20 I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

- 1 Peter 1:18-19 (NIV) ¹⁸ For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors, ¹⁹ but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect.
 - Pick up the cross because of freedom

We follow Jesus — because we could not defeat self on our own

- **2 Corinthians 4:11** (NiV) ¹¹ For we who are alive are always being given over to death for Jesus' sake, so that his life may also be revealed in our mortal body.
 - We have a new life in Jesus
