What might Rachel's theft of the household idols reveal about her faith or worldview at this point? 6) Read aloud Genesis 31:36-42. What can we learn from Jacob about enduring unfair treatment with integrity? 7) Read aloud Genesis 31:43-55. How does the covenant at Mizpah reflect some reconciliation and some lingering distrust between Jacob and Laban? 8) Read aloud Romans 12:18. Who might God be calling you try to live at peace with this week?
