Greatest Hits: Water into Wine

- 1) Read aloud **John 2:1-5**. What stands out to you about the setting—a wedding in Cana?
Why might Jesus choose this moment for His first sign?

- 2) What does this passage teach us about bringing ordinary needs (even social embarrassment) to Jesus?

- 3) Read aloud **John 2:6-10**. The servants had to fill large jars with water before seeing the miracle.
What does this say about participating in God's work? What does that teach about faith and obedience?

- 4) Where in your life might Jesus be asking you to trust Him before you see the outcome?

- 5) What is your relationship like with alcohol (wine, beer, liquor)?
Is it non-existent, a healthy balance, or is it problematic?

- 6) Read aloud **John 2:11**. Why might the author, John, call miracles “signs” instead of simply “miracles”? What does that suggest about their purpose?

- 7) How does this story reshape your understanding of joy, celebration, and the Christian life?
Does Jesus making this party WAY BETTER change your view of his personality and character?
