#1 LISTEN TO HOLY SPIRIT

- the prayer model is a helpful guideline -

Healing is about His Presence and doing what He wants to do.



Testimony is sharing what God has done in your life.

A testimony bears witness to a dynamic spiritual reality.

Salvation – giving witness to the power of the Lord Jesus Christ to save sinners – a transformation that you, as the redeemed, have personally experienced.

Mighty works – giving witness to the mighty works of God in our lives.

Both have the power to stir faith in those listening so that they can believe for salvation and for faith for healing.



When you share, listen to or read about testimonies, your faith is ignited to believe God for greater things.

When you share these testimonies with those in need of healing, you can help build their faith.

When we have been qualified by Christ, every healing story or experience is ours to share – to accomplish the same goal – building faith to believe God for healing.

Psalm 119:111 - I have inherited Your testimonies forever, for they are the joy of my heart



THE PURPOSE AND POWER OF TESTIMONY

Testimony Encourages Praise

- Psalm 71: 15-18
- Stories of God's strength and power incite praise as we are confronted with the reality of God in every day life.
- When we share testimonies of Jesus's healing, we are representing the very nature of God.
- This stirs a climate of praise, thanksgiving and worship in our hearts.



Testimonies introduce people to hope.

- Testimonies expose people to new possibilities.
- New possibilities of healing, deliverance, and freedom that they may never have heard of.
- You are bringing hope to the hopeless by sharing the miracle stories of God's supernatural healing power.
- Mark 5:19 And He did not permit him but said to him, "Go home to your friends and tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and how He has had mercy on you.



Testimony keeps us close to God

- When we talk about what God is doing, we are ever reminded that God is real.
- Testimonies set the imminence of God before us. He is present, He is real.
- We live differently, think different and act differently.



Testimony gives us supernatural courage.

- Testimonies empower you to go into battle with confidence.
- When you keep the track record of God's mighty works in front of you will be able to measure whatever you are coming against with the history of God's faithfulness.
- Faithfully sharing what God is doing/or has done, allows those healings to be repeated.
- If you want to create a culture of healing in your life, you must talk about what Jesus has done.



Jesus is eternally unchanging

Hebrews 1:12 – You remain the same, and Your years will never end.

Hebrews 13:8 - Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

If Jesus is the same yesterday, today, and forever, this means that God the Father is unchanging too. Jesus does not go around changing His mind about who He is. He has always been good and will always be good.

Revelation 19:10 – Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.
