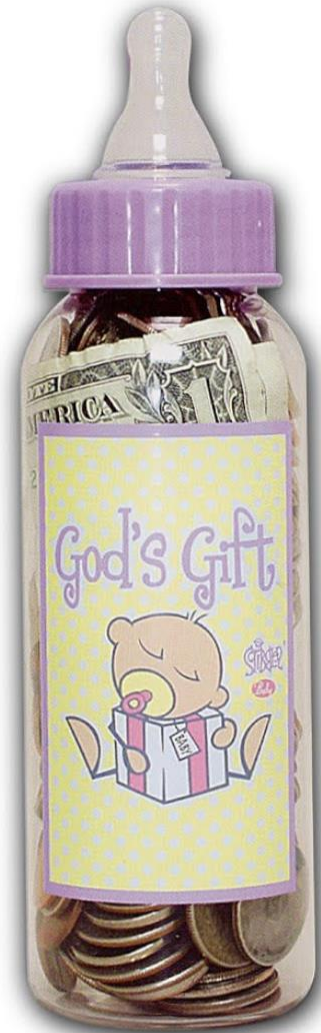

Acts 11:19-24 (NIV)

Now those who had been scattered by the persecution that broke out when Stephen was killed traveled as far as Phoenicia, Cyprus and Antioch, spreading the word only among Jews.

²⁰ Some of them, however, men from Cyprus and Cyrene, went to Antioch and began to speak to Greeks also, telling them the good news about the Lord Jesus. ²¹ *The Lord's hand was with them*, and a great number of people believed and turned to the Lord.

Acts 11:19-24 (NIV)

²²News of this reached the church in Jerusalem, and they sent Barnabas to Antioch. ²³ When he arrived and saw what the grace of God had done, he was glad and encouraged them all to remain true to the Lord with all their hearts. ²⁴ He was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and faith, and a great number of people were brought to the Lord.

Acts 12:1-4

(NIV)

It was about this time that **King Herod** arrested **some who** belonged to **the church**, intending to **persecute** them. ² He had **James**, the **brother of John**, put to **death** with the sword. ³ When **he saw** that this **met with approval** among the Jews, he **proceeded** to **seize Peter** also. This happened during the Festival of Unleavened Bread. ⁴ After arresting him, he put him in prison, handing him over to be guarded by four squads of four soldiers each. **Herod intended** to bring **him out** for **public trial** after the Passover.

Acts 12:21-24 (NIV)

On the appointed day [In Caesarea] **Herod**, wearing his royal robes, sat on his throne and delivered a public address to the people.

²² They shouted, “**This is the voice of a god, not of a man.**”

²³ **Immediately**, because **Herod did not** give praise **to God**, an **angel** of the Lord **struck him down**, and he was eaten by worms and died.

²⁴ ***But the word of God continued to spread and flourish.***

Acts 13:1-3

(NIV)

Now in the church at Antioch there were prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen (who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch) and Saul. ² While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, “Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them.” ³ So after they had fasted and prayed, they placed their hands on them and sent them off. [1st missions trip]

Acts 14:26-28

(ICB)

And from there [ending 1st missions trip] they [Paul and Barnabas] sailed away to Antioch. This is where the believers had put them into God's care and had sent them out to do this work. And now they had finished the work.

²⁷ When they arrived in Antioch, they gathered the church together. Paul and Barnabas told them all about what God had done with them. They told how God had made it possible for the non-Jews to believe! ²⁸ And they stayed there a long time with the followers.

Acts 11:19-21 (NIV)

Now those who had been scattered by the persecution that broke out when Stephen was killed traveled as far as Phoenicia, Cyprus and Antioch, spreading the word only among Jews.

²⁰ Some of them, however, men from Cyprus and Cyrene, went to Antioch and began to speak to Greeks also, telling them the good news about the Lord Jesus. ²¹ *The Lord's hand was with them*, and a great number of people believed and turned to the Lord.

Acts 15:1-2

(NIV)

Certain people came down from Judea to Antioch and were teaching the believers: “Unless you are *circumcised*, according to the custom taught by Moses, you cannot be saved.”² This brought Paul and Barnabas into sharp dispute and debate with them. So Paul and Barnabas were appointed, along with some other believers, to go up to Jerusalem to see the apostles and elders about this question.

Acts 15:6-11

(NIV)

The apostles and elders met to consider this question. ⁷ After much discussion, **Peter** got up and addressed them: “**Brothers**, you know that some time ago God made a choice among you that **the Gentiles** might hear from my lips the message of **the gospel** and **believe**.
⁸ **God**, who **knows the heart**, showed that **He accepted them** by giving **the Holy Spirit** to **them**, just as **He did** to **us**.”

Acts 15:6-11

(NIV)

Barnabas...

“For many decades the church in Antioch was second only to the church in Jerusalem. It played a major role in sending out missionaries and in determining church doctrine.

Antioch was an important part of the Christians understanding that Christ was going to grow His Kingdom through His body the church.

Ecclesia - the Greek word for church means an assembly.

Barnabas...

Antioch was the first place that proved the assembly of believers were **a community** of those who trust in Jesus Christ. And **gathered to express their beliefs** without **regard to whether** they were **Jews or gentiles**.

It was **the cradle** of **gentile Christianity**.

Here's the crazy part... a **church community** is supposed to **reflect the community** that is found among the **Father, Son** and **Holy Spirit**. It is **to reflect** God's **divine nature**;

They planned the church in eternity past
and we got to see it come into existence.”


