"Community"

"I am the first to agree that communication does not require explicit definition of every term. But in the case of a vague public goal like "community," agreeing on the results we want will help clarify our discussions of how to achieve them. Indeed, we court undesirable consequences by leaving the term undefined.

I have often heard people use a cloudy, visionless notion of community as "something that we need more of."

Such statements are very clever when used to support a favorite idea, because their meaninglessness makes them unassailable.
