
- Philia generally refers to affection between friends.
- Agape typically defined as "self-sacrificing love."

This is the love that moves people into action (deeds) and looks out for the well-being of others, no matter the personal cost.

Biblically speaking, agape is the love God showed to His people in sending His Son, Jesus, to die for their sins.

It is the love that focuses on the will, not the emotions or experience. This is the love that Jesus commands His disciples to show (deeds) toward their enemies




