

Rather than staying on the path to maturity (which includes increasing acknowledge) they take a different road that focuses primarily on attaining information. While they are increasing in knowledge


they are not growing in humility. While they are filling their minds with information

they are not emptying themselves for the needy.

They aren't leading others by living life with them and modeling the fruit of the spirit. As a result we have people who see themselves as mature because they know so many things about scripture but their lives look nothing like that of Christ."

PRAY for the small community of Christians

who remain in Afghanistan after the Taliban's takeover. Ask God to provide for their needs, give them protection, and let them know they are not alone, and the worldwide Church stands with them

PRAY for Christians in Egypt, Iraq and Syria

to have the courage and wisdom to be bold for Jesus in the face of ongoing discrimination. And ask God to prepare Christians in some parts of the country for the reality of violent attacks by extremists.

PRAY for Christians in North Korea, Somalia, Eritrea, and Iran who are imprisoned or held captive for their faith. Ask God to give them the comfort of the Holy Spirit—and pray for their expedited release and freedom **PRAY for young Christian girls** who face the threat of abduction and forced marriage in Muslim majority countries like Egypt. Ask God to move the authorities to take these abductions seriously and prosecute the perpetrators swiftly and with justice.

PRAY for persecuted Christians who have been displaced from their homes by extremist attacks in countries like Nigeria, Egypt, Syria and Burkina Faso. These believers have lost all their earthly belongings. Pray that God would provide for their needs and that they would know they are not alone.

PRAY for the pastors and Christian leaders of the persecuted Church. Ask God to give them wisdom in leading their congregations, guiding them to be prepared for persecution—helping them forgive and love their enemies
