

Until Unity – Am I the Problem?

Repentance - Defined



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- * Many understand the term repentance to mean "a turning from sin." Regretting sin and turning from it is related to repentance, but it is not the precise meaning of the word.

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- * The Bible also tells us that true repentance will result in a change of actions (Luke 3:8–14; Acts 3:19).
- * Two conditions of repentance are:

 "to turn from evil, and to turn to God."

 both motive and conduct are to be radically changed.



1 Corinthians 13:8-12

(ESV)

Love never ends. As for prophecies, they will pass away; as for tongues, they will cease; as for knowledge, it will pass away.

⁹ For we know in part and we prophesy in part, ¹⁰ but when the perfect comes, the partial will pass away. ¹¹ When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I gave up childish ways

¹² For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I have been fully known.



"Any knowledge of God that we would think we have here on earth, everything that the most brilliant scholars have ever grasped of heavenly truth, is like a dim reflection of real truth in a mirror.

Not like one of the mirrors we have today, but like a piece of shiny metal that you can just barely make out your face in. It's childish. It's temporary.

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If you're having a hard time accepting that or are starting to feel defensive, stop right now and check your heart.

As for me, it matters very little how I might be evaluated by you or by any human authority. I don't even trust my own judgment on this point. ⁴ My conscience is clear, but that doesn't prove I'm right. It is the Lord himself who will examine me and decide.

⁵ So don't make judgments about anyone ahead of time—before the Lord returns. For He will bring our darkest secrets to light and will reveal our private motives. Then God will give to each one whatever praise is due.



1 Corinthians 4:3-5 (MSG)

It matters very little to me what you think of me, even less where I rank in popular opinion. I don't even rank myself. Comparisons in these matters are pointless. I'm not aware of anything that would disqualify me from being a good guide for you, but that doesn't mean much. The *Master* makes that judgment.

⁵ So don't get ahead of the Master and jump to conclusions with your judgments before all the evidence is in. When He comes, He will bring out in the open and place in evidence all kinds of things we never even dreamed of—inner motives and purposes and prayers.

Only then will any one of us get to hear the "Well done!" of God.



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"Too often we fixate on our disagreements, and we feel like we can't worship with such big elephants in the room. We don't see that God is infinitely larger than our elephants, or He is worthy of our attention and praise –

Even if we sit amidst a herd of elephants.
