Romans 12:1

And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to give your *bodies* to God *because of all He has done for you*. Let *them* be a *living and holy sacrifice*—the kind He will find acceptable. This is truly *the way to worship Him*.

1. By Taking our Thoughts Captive and subject them to Christ

2 Corinthians 10:5 (NIV)

We *demolish* arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we *take captive* every *thought* to make it *obedient to Christ*.



2. Develop a Biblical Worldview

Colossians 3:16-17 (NIV)

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God.

Matthew 28: 19-20

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.

3. By Guarding our Minds with Prayer

Philippians 4:6-7 (NIV)

Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. 7 And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

4. By Drawing near to God He will draw near to you.

James 4:8

(NIV)

Come near to God and he will come near to you.

Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts,
you double-minded.

5. By Choosing our Focus.

Philippians 4:8 (NIV)

Finally, brothers and sisters,
whatever is true,
whatever is noble,
whatever is right,
whatever is pure,
whatever is lovely,
whatever is admirable—
if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—
think about such things.



6. By Engaging in Godly Fellowship

Proverbs 27:17 (NIV)
