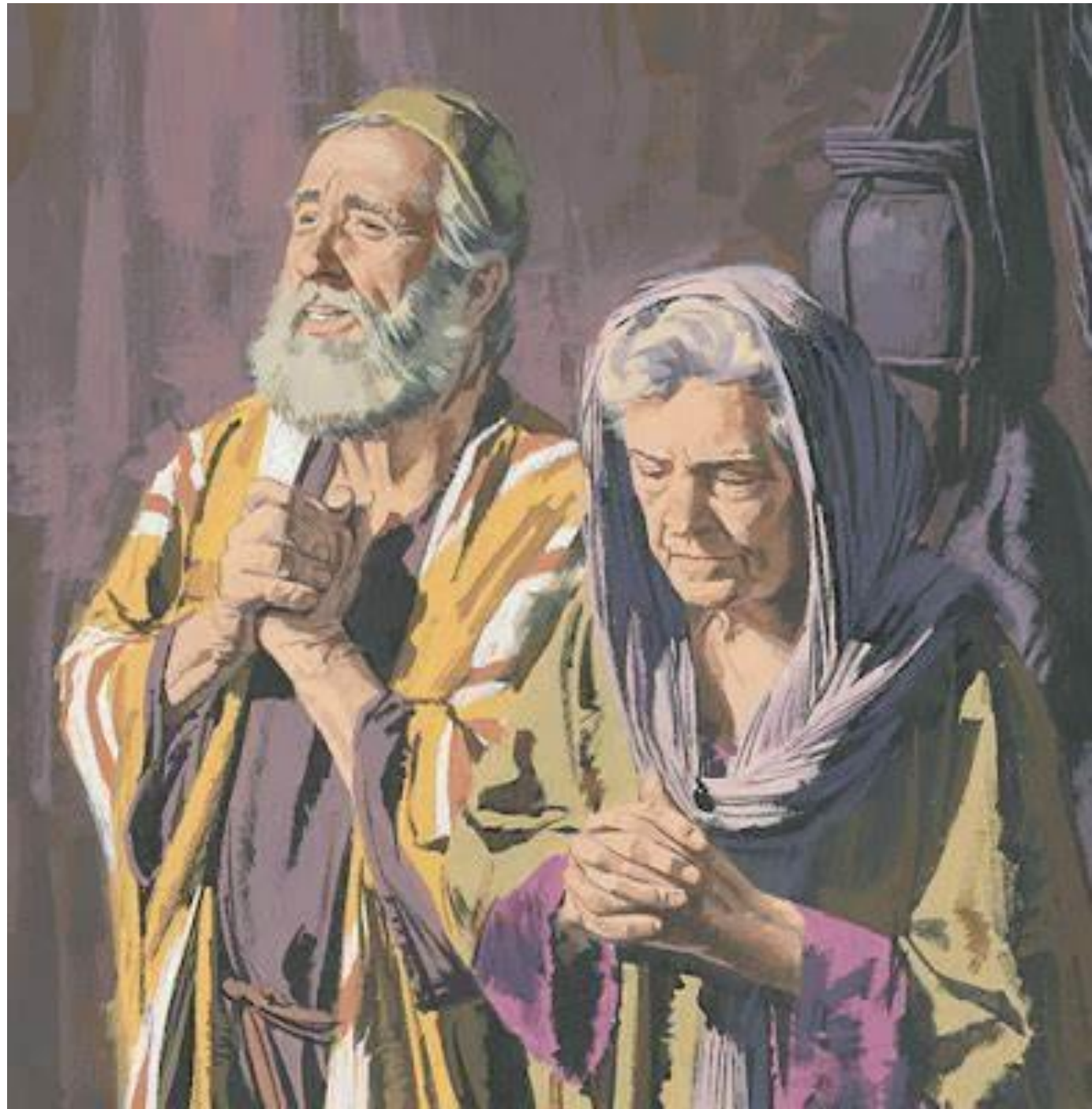

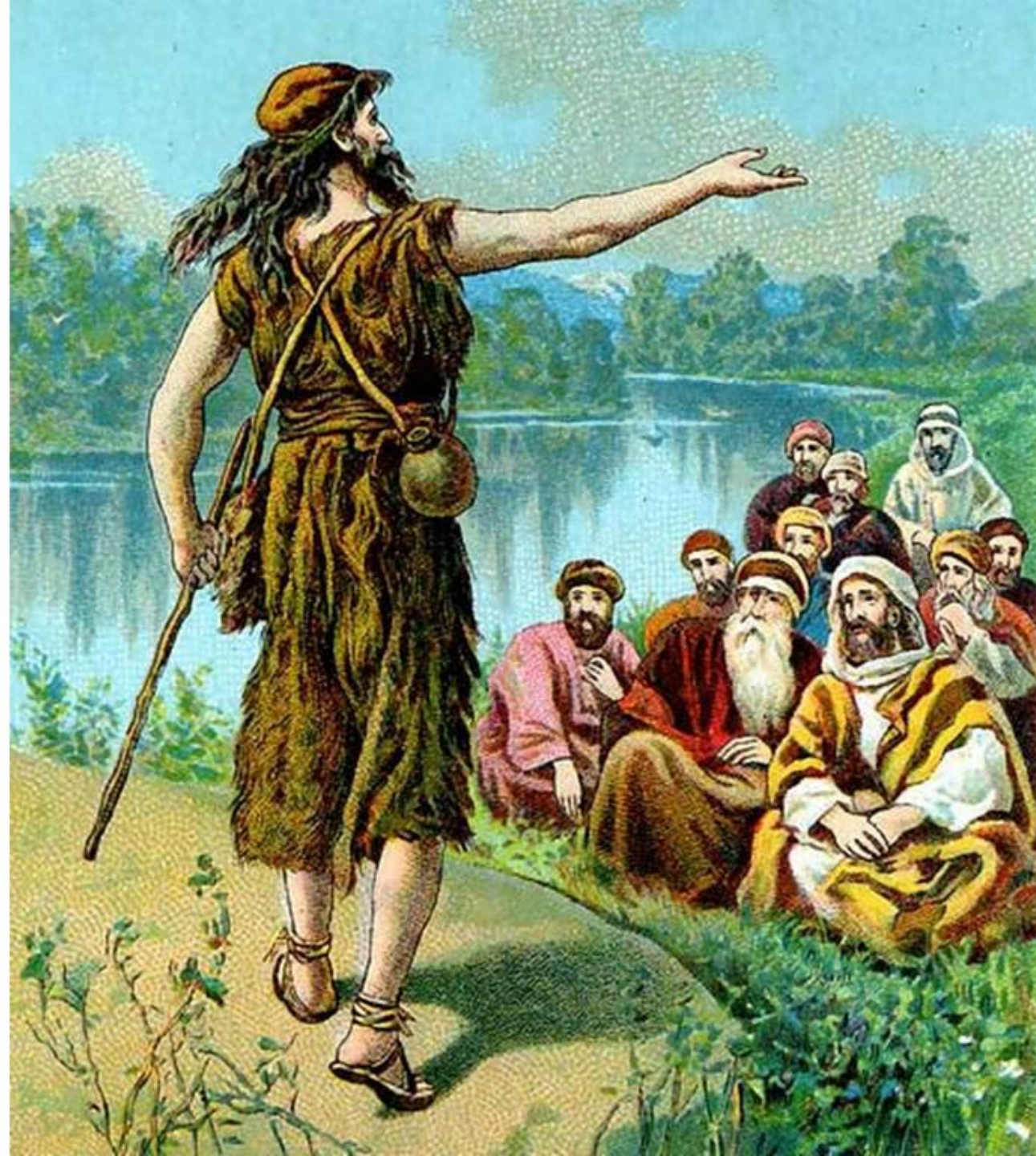

For you will go on BEFORE THE LORD TO PREPARE HIS WAYS;**

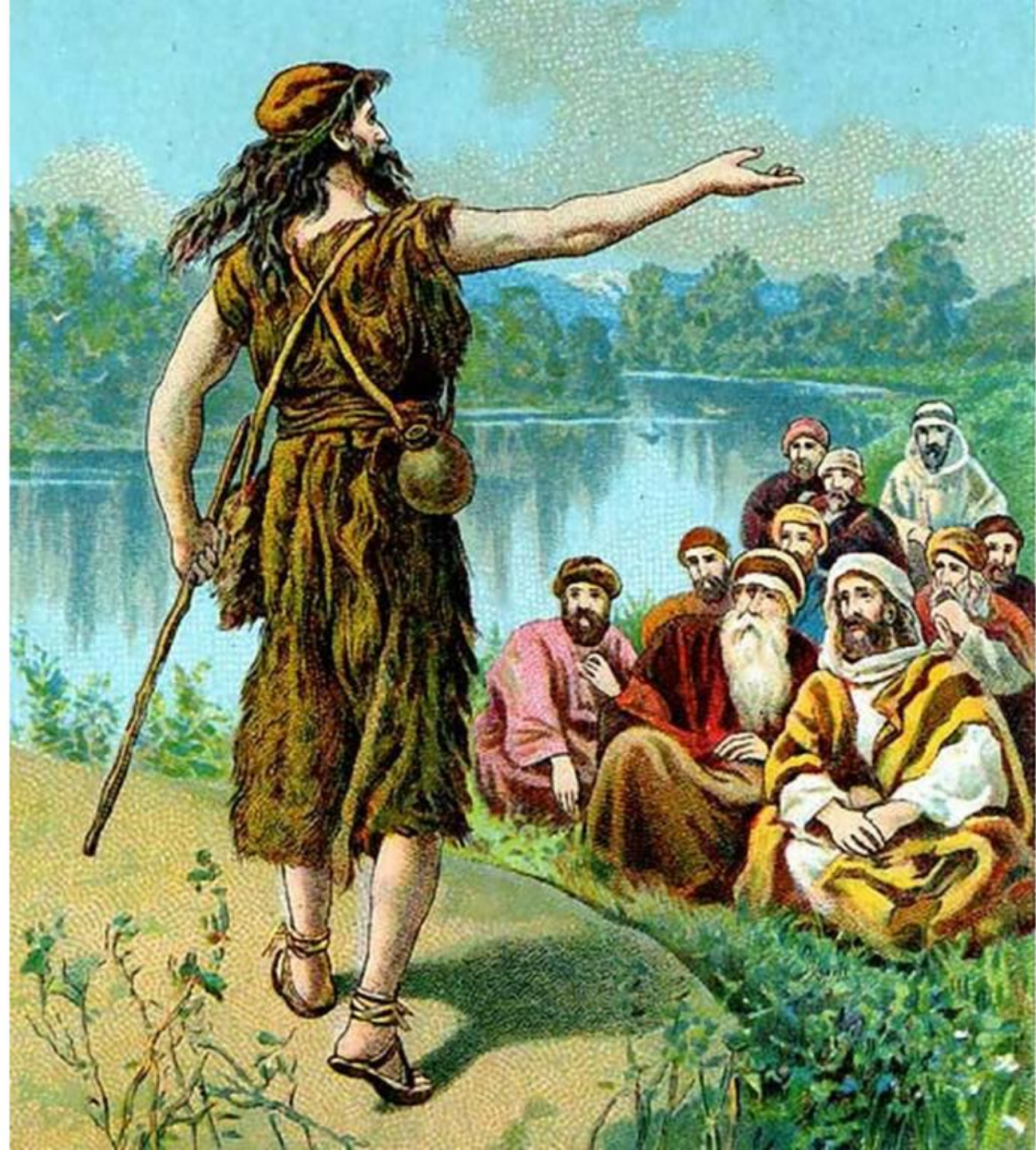

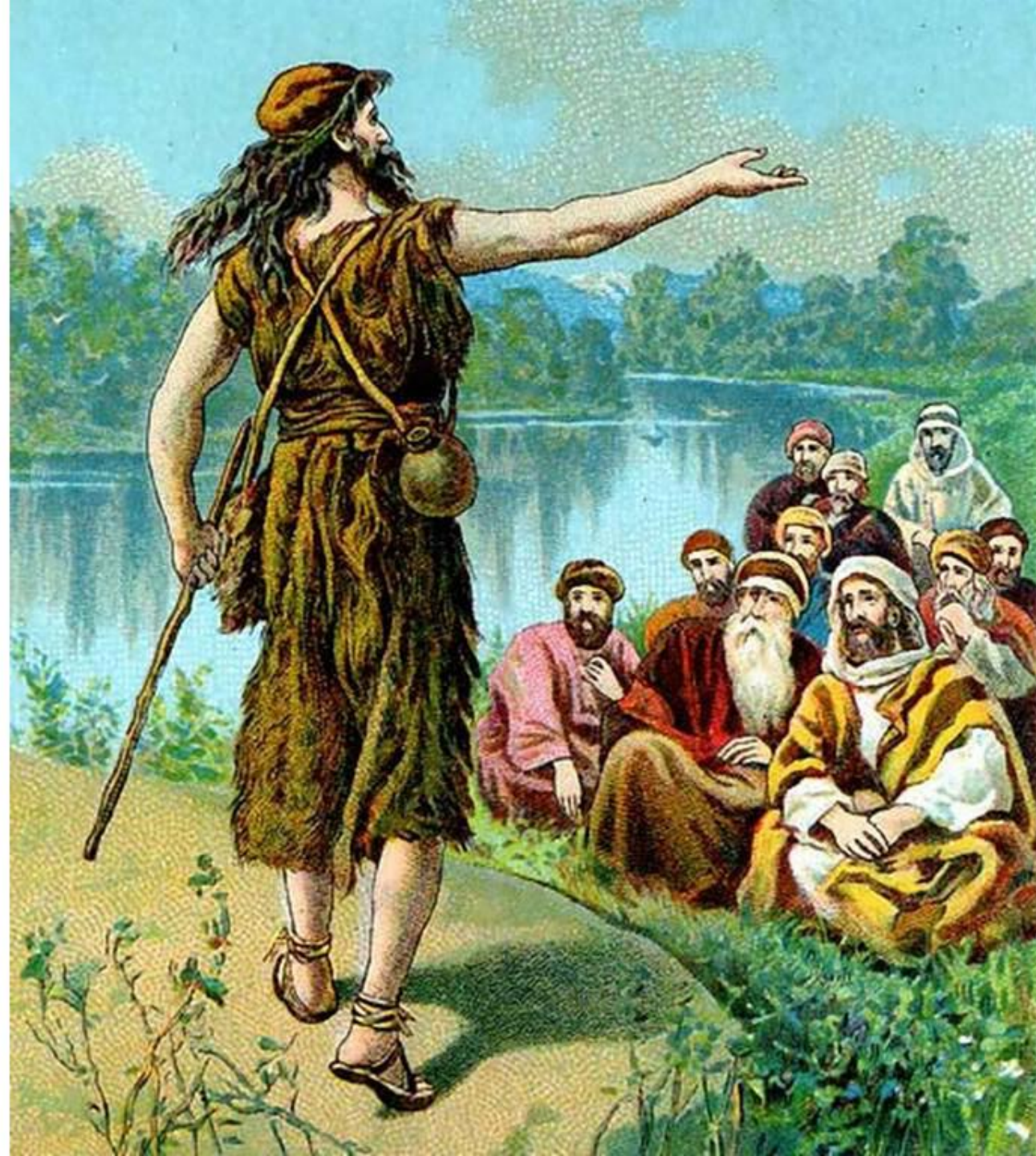
**Luk 3:7** So he began saying to the crowds who were going out to be baptized by him, "You brood of vipers, who warned you to flee from the wrath to come?"
