
Convergence – *Praying for Afghanistan*

- Pray for those fleeing to the hills to be protected
- Pray for miraculous protection for women and children from being forcibly taken and...
- Pray that those who have already been taken for their protection, salvation, and deliverance.
- Pray that the Afghan Church steps into her identity in Christ and walks in unity with the Holy Spirit.
- Pray that the Afghan church would grow in unity and in numbers.
- Christians from the growing church in Iran often bring the gospel to Afghanistan. Pray with Iranian believers who are sharing their faith in Christ and the hearts of Afghanistan men, women and children. Ask God to open their eyes to Jesus' love for them as they learn about Christ and hear His gospel.

Prayer Teams:

- Pray for the Taliban leaders and those they lead to come to Christ. Pray that God would visit them in their dreams and that the Holy Spirit would relentlessly pursue them.
- pray for wisdom. Ask God to bless our brothers and sisters with discernment as they decide whether to stay or go and even with whom they should talk.
- Pray for the Christian ministries that are trying to find the pathways to bring provisions and encouragement to the Afghan church.
- Pray for fellowship. Believers in Afghanistan often must keep their faith a secret — even from family members.
- Pray that God will help each Afghan believer to connect and fellowship with at least one other believer in person, by phone or through some other technology. Pray that God will remind them that they are not alone, but are part of the global body of Christ.
