Week 4 - Perseverance

You must not shrink back from *the reality that not everyone gets healed.*

You must learn to *persevere* through disappointment & discouragement.

DON'T GIVE UP!

Galatians 6:9

Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.

You respond by learning to press ahead and to continue despite the disappointments, discouragement and pain of the healing ministry.



School of Healing -

Week 4 - Perseverance

Healing is part of the cross that Jesus Himself calls you to take up as you follow His example.

The healing ministry *is truly costly*.

Luke 9:23 – "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me."

There is no resurrection life without the suffering of the cross.

Jesus commissions you as His disciples in Matthew 10:7-8... to preach the good news of the Kingdom, to heal the sick and to cast out demons.

Lack of a healing *does not disqualify* you from continuing to accomplish Jesus's great commission.



You CANNOT create a theology *based on your experience of what* you have or have not seen.

When your *theology* is based entirely upon what you see or do not see in your own personal experience, *disappointment becomes* stronger than the truth of God's Word.

You CANNOT allow your experience with disappointment to detour you from what Jesus clearly told you to do.

Jesus told you to pray for the sick and that is what you must do!

Your responsibility is simply to *preach* the Word of God!



PRAY FOR TWO THINGS:

More *power* andmore

You need both *God's heart* and *God's power* to fully continue the healing ministry of Jesus.

Let's pray together:

Father,

I ask You to keep me humble, give me Your compassion and Your heart for the lost and the sick, and finally, give me the power of Your anointing to do something about it.

Amen.



You must not *deny* the sick the chance to be healed because you have experienced disappointment.

You must *leave the results* of your prayers in God's hands where they belong.

You must *be willing to embrace* emotional suffering and be willing to say, "I don't know."

You must not get *discouraged* by what *you don't see happening*.

Continue to pray for the sick, taking up your cross and following

Christ.

You must keep praying and trust the results to the Healer.



God is calling you out beyond the comfortable and beckoning you into *a lifestyle of taking up His cross*.

- He is calling you to be on fire with the Holy Spirit and His power.
- He is calling you to be bold and power-filled.
- He is restoring you, as His church, to an authentic expression of New Testament signs, wonders and miracles.
- God's anointing is a call to radically follow the model of Jesus Christ.
- Draw from the deep well of His strength and ability.

Let us pray for *a fresh baptism of the Holy Spirit* to give us

The *power to work miracles*, and
the *power to walk through the darkness when*the *miracles do not come*.

We should expect a lifetime of continuous, increased anointing.

Press through *from* disappointment *to* Obedience.
