Ephesians 4:11-16

It was He who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, ¹²to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up ¹³until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

¹⁴Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of men in their deceitful scheming. ¹⁵Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will in *all* things grow up *into Him* who is the Head, that is, Christ. ¹⁶From Him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.

Luke 8:11-15 (The Parable of the Seed)

This is the meaning of the parable: The seed is the word of God.

12Those along the path are the ones who hear, and then the devil comes and takes away the word from their hearts, so that they may not believe and be saved.

13Those on the rock are the ones who receive the word with joy when they hear it, but they have no root. They believe for a while, but in the time of testing they fall away.



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¹⁴The seed that fell among thorns stands for those who hear, but as *they go* on *their* way they are choked by life's worries, riches and pleasures, and they *do not mature*.



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¹⁵But the seed on good soil stands for those with a noble (righteous) and good heart, who *hear the word*, *retain it*, and by *persevering* (stand firm, are resolute) *produce a crop*.
