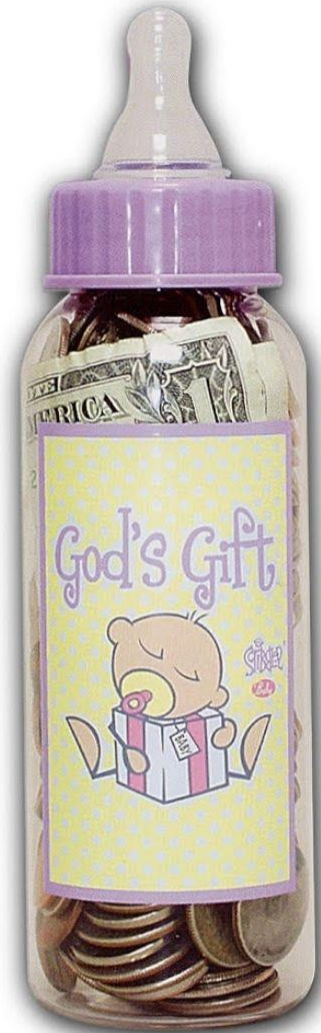

**Acts 1:4-9** (NIV)

On one occasion, while He was eating with them, He gave them this command: “Do not leave Jerusalem, but **wait for the gift my Father promised**, which you have heard Me speak about. <sup>5</sup> For John baptized with water, but **in a few days** you will **be baptized with the Holy Spirit.**”

<sup>6</sup> Then they gathered around Him and asked Him, “Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?”

<sup>39</sup> The ***promise is for you*** and ***your children*** and ***for all*** who are far ***off***—for ***all whom*** the Lord ***our God will call***.”

<sup>41</sup> Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day.
