III. Good Questions about the Greatest Commandment

Q1: How do I know if I love God?

• If you've been born again, you love God (Deut. 30:6, 1 Cor. 16:22)

Q2: How can I grow in my love for God?

- Ask God to grow your love for Him (Matt. 7:11)
- Meditate on God's love for you (Ephesians 3:18-19)
- Tell God you love him (Psalm 18:1)

Q3: How can I show my love for God?

- Give Allegiance to God (Mark 12:29-30)
- Express Affection for God

- 1. How can we discern if we merely have an intellectual knowledge about God, or if we have a real loving relationship with God?
- 2. Do you think it's possible for people to be "religious" without truly loving God?
