A HYMN OF PRAISE (Ephesians 1:3-14)

Paul wrote one amazing sentence, phrase upon phrase, excitedly overwhelmed with the grace of God's loving plan to us.

- 1:3-6 PRAISE to the Father who chose us in the PAST "...to the praise of the glory of His grace" (1:6)
- 1:7-12 PRAISE to the Son who redeems us in the PRESENT "...to the praise of His glory" (1:12)
- 1:13-14 PRAISE to the Holy Spirit who seals us for the FUTURE "...to the praise of His glory (1:14)
