GOD'S SCOURGE 2 Kings 10

FROM PASTOR MARK

The lives of Elijah and Elisha remind us that, "God buries his workers, but continues His work." According to 1 Kings 19:15-17, Elijah was to anoint Elisha, Jehu, and Hazael. Elijah did anoint Elisha; but it was Elisha who anointed Hazel and one of Elisha's disciples who anointed Jehu. Pastor Phillip introduced us to Jehu in 2 Kings 9 and reminded us that, "God judges sin in His time and His way." Chapter 10 unfolds more about God's justice and the need to evaluate our true heart.
