In the Days of Elisha, God was calling Israel back to Himself and even showed mercy to the enemy nation of Syria. In spite of that mercy Syria quickly returned and the northern kingdom of Israel found itself on the ropes. God's Word was needed desperately and God continued to reveal it through His prophet.
