Elijah passed the baton (mantle) to Elisha who asked, "where is Yahweh, the God of Elijah." Throughout 50 years of ministry, Yahweh was faithful and worked through the prophet Elisha. - 4. Also, how do these same attributes of God show up through the reality of Christmas?
- 5. Read Hebrews 13:8. Why is it such good news that our Savior is immutable?
- 6. Spend some time praying for IBC's Christmas outreach and for your own witness this Christmas.
