

Living Light Titus 2:7-10

Titus 2:1-10 displays Godly living that will be a light to a lost world. In every stage of life and in every circumstance, Paul provides concrete examples of what a Godly life looks like. It is in stark contrast to the description of false teachers in Titus 1:16 who, “profess to know God, but deny him by their works.”

I. Why is Godly living important?

- So that the word of God may not be **reviled** (v. 5)
- So that an opponent may be put to **shame**, having **nothing evil** to say about us (v. 8)
- So that in everything they may **adorn** the doctrine of God (v. 10)

II. What does Godly living look like?

 - Younger men
 - Common theme: **Self- Control**
- A word to **Titus**- an example disciple-maker
 - Model **good works** in **everything**
 - Are you an example worth following?
 - In your teaching
 - Show **integrity- live** what you **teach**
 - **Dignity**
 - **Sound speech**
- A word to **slaves**
 - Be **submissive**
 - Be **well-pleasing**
 - Not argumentative
 - Not pilfering
 - Showing yourself to be trustworthy
