John 14:1-15

Stress and anxiety fill our world. The One who stilled the storm provided His disciples with the prescription for inner peace, come what may. Jesus was "troubled" but did not sin (13:21). In John 14, He told His followers how they can deal with their "troubles," and experience His peace.
