- I. Pray to the **<u>Father</u>** (Eph. 3:14-15)
- II. Pray for **growth** (Eph. 3:16-19)
 - A. Strength
 - a. through **power** of **Spirit** in **inner being**
 - b. that **Christ** may **dwell in your heart** through **faith**
 - B. Love
- a. **Rooted**
- b. **Grounded**
- C. Knowledge
 - a. **breath** of Christ's love- to include all mankind
 - b. **length** of Christ's love- for all eternity
 - c. **height** of Christ's love- reaching to heaven
 - d. depth of Christ's love-reaching the worst of sinners
- D. Fullness
 - a. filled or controlled
 - b. Fullness of God (also fullness of Christ in 4:13, and Spirit 5:18)
- III. Pray **big** prayers for God's **glory** (Eph. 3:20-21)
 - A. God is **able**
 - B. The limit in prayer is not God's **ability**, but our **imagination**
- C. The purpose of our prayer is not for our **pleasures**, but God's **glory** (James 4:2-3)
