I. Pray to the **Father** (Eph. 3:14-15)

II. Pray for **growth** (Eph. 3:16-19)

A. Strength

a. through **power** of **Spirit** in **inner being**

b. that **Christ** may  **dwell in your heart**  through **faith**

B. Love

a. **Rooted**

b. **Grounded**

C. Knowledge

a. **breath** of Christ's love- to include all mankind

b. **length** of Christ's love- for all eternity

c. **height** of Christ's love- reaching to heaven

d. **depth** of Christ's love- reaching the worst of sinners

D. Fullness

a. filled or controlled

b. Fullness of God (also fullness of Christ in 4:13, and Spirit 5:18)

III. Pray **big** prayers for God's **glory** (Eph. 3:20-21)

A. God is **able**

B. The limit in prayer is not God's **ability**, but our **imagination**

C. The purpose of our prayer is not for our **pleasures**, but  
God's **glory** (James 4:2-3)
