# **HOPE**

#### **Deuteronomy 30**

#### **From Pastor Mark**

In Deuteronomy 29, Moses called Israel to renew their commitment to keep God's Covenant, but told them they wouldn't have a heart to keep it since God hadn't given them such a heart (29:4). How would this fit together? Dt. 29:29 comforts our confusion and then, Dt. 30 gives HOPE in God and His ultimate plan and mercy. How can wayward hearts be changed?

## I. GOD'S PROMISE GIVES US HOPE (30:1-10).

- B. The Fulfillment in Christ (Rom. 10:5-10)

## III. GOD'S PERSON GIVES US HOPE (30:15-20).

- A. The Ultimate Invitation (15-19)
- B. The Ultimate Blessing (20)

#### TO DISCUSS WITH FAMILY AND FRIENDS:

- 1. Read Deuteronomy 30:6. What evidence do you see that God has changed you inside so that you love Him with all your heart?
- 2. Moses called the new generation to choose loyalty to God and the good life that He wanted to give them (Dt. 30:15-18). How can we encourage our children and grandchildren to choose the Lord?
