Be mindful of the rubbish. In Nehemiah 4:10 Judah is discouraged after building the wall half way. His concern is they are tired and there is just so much rubbish. When I think of rubbish, I think of the broken down walls of Jerusalem. When I think of the broken walls of Jerusalem I think of the broken areas of our lives as well as distractions.

The greatest hindrance to prayer, to personal renewal and to revival of a church is rubbish. If we choose revival we must choose to focus on God and resist the distractions.

The Lord, by His Spirit, is ready to reveal the rubbish in our lives. This is an uncomfortable but necessary step to personal transformation.

Remember that distractions may not be bad things in and of themselves; just things we allow to push God out of our lives. Distractions may be hobbies, video games, sports, social or service clubs, or any special interest.

Today pray about the "rubbish" in your life and seek God first.
