Who can trust God?
You can trust God.

Matthew 14:22-33
Jesus shows Peter that he can trust God when He helps Peter walk to Him on water.

Do This



Morning Time

When you go into your child’s room, say, “Good morning, [name of child]! Guess who can trust God today! (*Pick up your child or tickle them.*) “YOU CAN! I can trust God, and YOU can trust God!”



Drive Time

As you drive or take a walk, talk about the different things you are driving/walking on, such as a driveway, road, parking lot, highway, rocks, dirt, sticks, etc. Talk about how Jesus helped Peter walk on water. Wow! Only Jesus can do that! Jesus wanted to show Peter that he can trust God, because God really can do anything! And the best part is we can trust God, too!”



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, “Dear God, thank You for another great day with [name of child]. [He, She] is learning all kinds of new things. I pray we can keep learning about all the things Jesus came to teach us, like how we can trust You with all of our hearts. Help us to keep following Jesus so we can trust You more and more and more. We love You, God. In Jesus’ name, amen.”



Bath Time

Add a toy boat to bath time. Use your fingers on one hand to be Jesus walking on water towards the boat. Use your fingers on the other hand to be Peter stepping out of the boat and walking on water towards Jesus. Encourage your child to do it, too. You can also do it together—one can be Peter and the other Jesus. Tell your child that Jesus helped Peter walk on water to show him he can trust God.
