A1. Often fear imagines what could happen. What do you use/do to manage the 'what ifs' ?

2. Read 2:41-52. Have you or your kids ever gotten separated from your parents or you? Describe the feelings you had.

3. Describe what is the emotion or energy you hear when you read verse 48?

4. Your fear response often is influenced by your experiences, which you can easily transfer to those close to you (i.e. bit by a dog when you were a child, you aid others to be scared of dogs). Have you witnessed fear transference? How can you challenge your own fear responses?

5. "How to Check your Fear" presents four additional tools to minimize fears dominance. Which has helped you? Where do you struggle? What would you like to work on?
