He's Alive

1 Corinthians 15:12-20

Of these four proofs of the resurrection of Jesus, understand it is an incontrovertible fact that Jesus actually did die on the cross. He had been beaten, whipped, nailed to a cross through His hands and feet, exposed naked all day, speared through his chest, and declared dead by a Roman centurion. He had been embalmed with over 80 pounds of chemicals, and His body was sealed in a tomb.

So there is no doubt that Jesus was dead, but the question is “Did He stay dead?” and if He didn’t, where is the proof? Well, here are three pieces of evidence you can’t ignore.

- The empty tomb.
- The eyewitness testimonies.
- The external transformation.
