EPISODE 3:

YOU'RE NOT DOING THIS ALONE

look back

First, **LOOK BACK** at the past week by asking, “How did we do?” Begin with prayer, then check in with one another—sharing honestly, celebrating victories, acknowledging struggles, and graciously offering practical help.



PRAYER - Begin by inviting Jesus into the conversation.

Follow up on last week's assignment (reach out to a specific grandchild, pray for their needs, and text to check in):

- What did your grandchild share with you?
- How did you pray for them, and did you send a follow-up text to check on those areas?
- What went well, and what was hard? How can the group support you this week?

Next, **LOOK UP** to God's Word by asking, “What does Jesus want us to know?” This part of the journey anchors you in the Scriptures and principles at the heart of the episode. If you haven't already, watch this week's video: “**Legacy Welcome Series: You're Not Doing This Alone.**” Then use the “What Do You Think?” and “What Does God's Word Say?” sections to draw out the main truths together.

Episode Summary

You are not alone in this calling. God's presence goes with you, and the Legacy Imperative platform exists to come alongside you with practical, Christ-centered tools. Start where you are, show up in love, and trust God to work through your steady presence and prayers.

HOW TO USE THESE RESOURCES

Whether you're studying on your own or with a group, each guide follows a simple yet powerful rhythm: **Look Back / Look Up / Look Forward.** For group leaders, additional instructions for leading a small group are included at the end of the first workbook in each series.

WHAT DO YOU THINK?

1. Have you ever felt alone in trying to pass on faith to your family?
2. What's something you've put off doing—big or small—because of fear?
3. Can you share a time when you were fearful or discouraged, but someone helped you through it?
4. This session reminds us of Jesus' promise, “I am with you always.” How does that encourage you in passing on a legacy of faith?
5. What are some ways that we, as grandparents in this group, can encourage and strengthen one another in our calling?

WHAT DOES GOD'S WORD SAY?

KEY VERSE

Hebrews 10:24–25 (NIV) – “And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.” God designed us for community. You are not alone—you have the body of Christ to encourage and strengthen you as you disciple your grandchildren.

SUPPORTING VERSES

Matthew 28:20b (NIV) – “And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.” Jesus’ promise anchors your mission: as you invest in your grandchildren, you never go alone—He is with you in every conversation and prayer.

Joshua 1:9 (NIV) – “Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.”

God’s presence fuels courage. Even when you feel uncertain, you can step forward in faith to bless the next generation.
