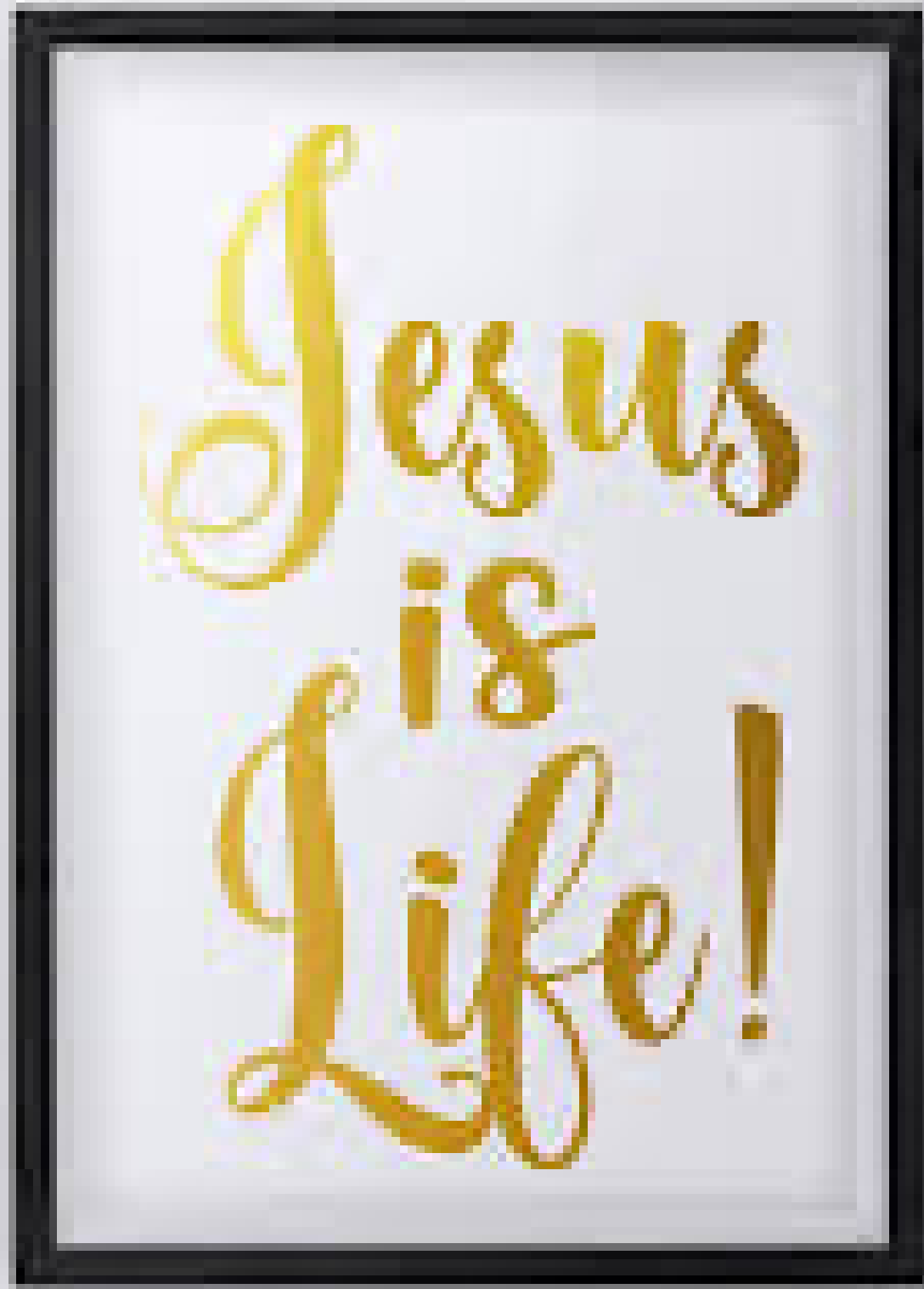

# Imputed Rewards of Righteousness.

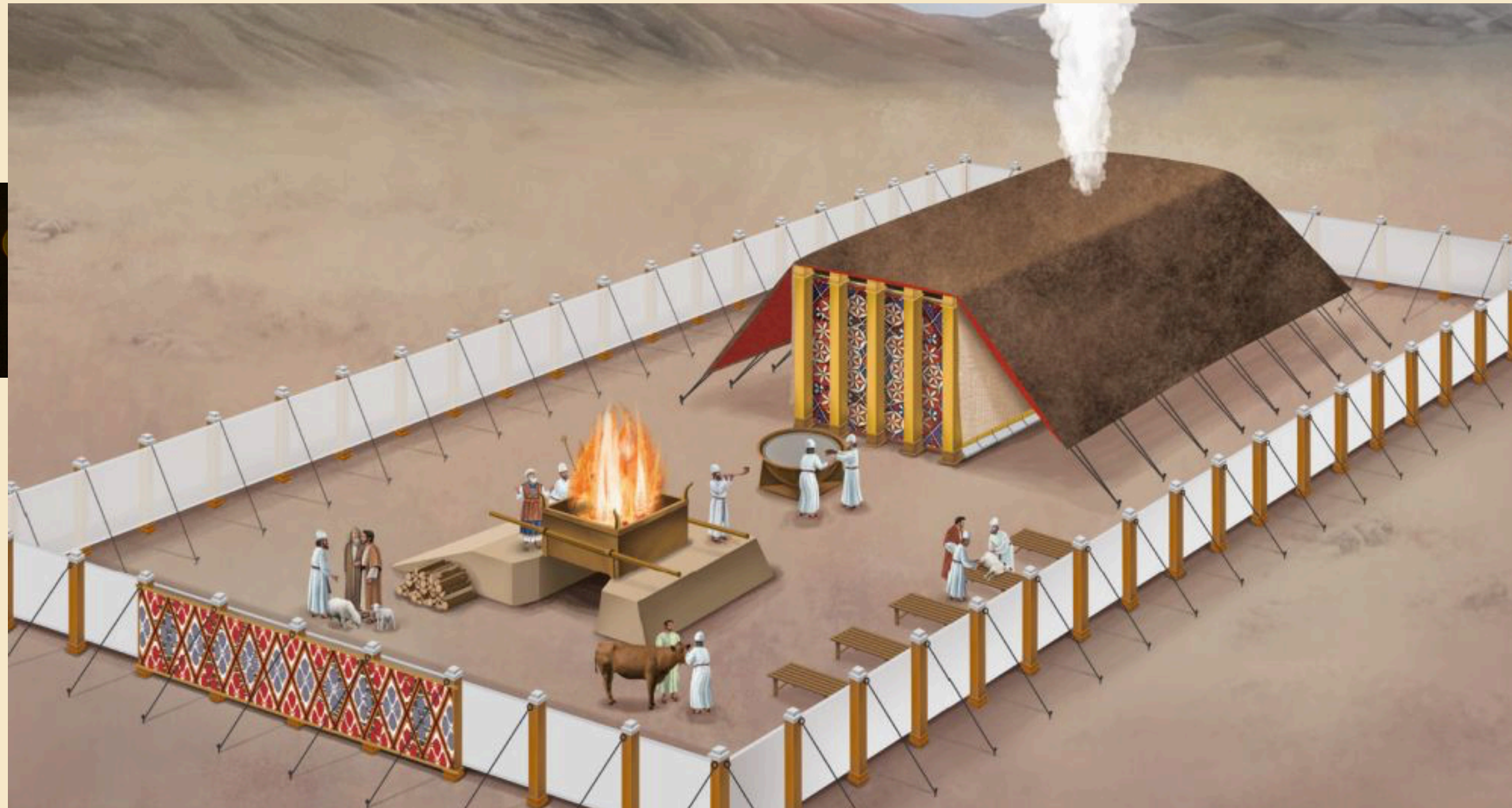

## Revelation 21:3-5
