²⁵ Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself serve the law of God with my mind, but with my flesh I serve the law of sin.

8 There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death. ³ For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do.

By sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, He condemned sin in the flesh, ⁴ in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

And have you forgotten the exhortation that addresses you as sons? "My son, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, nor be weary when reproved by Him. ⁶ For the Lord disciplines the one He loves, and chastises every son whom He receives." ⁷ It is for discipline that you have to endure. ³ Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, ⁴ even as He chose *me* in Him before the foundation of the world, that I should be holy and blameless before Him. In love ⁵ He predestined *me* for adoption to Himself as sons *or daughters* through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of His will, 6 to the praise of His glorious grace, with which He has blessed me in the Beloved. ⁷ In Him I have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of my trespasses, according to the riches of His grace, 8 which He lavished upon me, in all wisdom and insight 9 making known to me the mystery of His will, according to His purpose, which He set forth in Christ¹⁰ as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in Christ, things in heaven and things on earth in Him. ¹¹ In Him I have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will, 12 so that we who were the first to hope in Christ might be to the praise of His glory. 13 In Him I also, when I heard the word of truth, the gospel of my salvation, and believed in Him, was sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, 14 who is the guarantee of my inheritance until 1 acquire possession of it, to the praise of His glory.



JOHN 14:16-17 & 26

And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, ¹⁷ even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him. You know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.

²⁶ But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.
