# PRIORITIZE RELATIONSHIPS, FREQUENCY OF CONNECTION, AND DEPTH OF INTIMACY

Because we value authentic, intimate, and intentional Christian community we make every effort to prioritize relationships (marriages, families, friendships, mentorships, etc.) in our lives. We believe that relationships with other followers of Christ sharpens our faith. Loving others is the second commandment Jesus gave his followers after loving God. We aim to have regular (daily, weekly) connections with the Body of Christ and work towards familial intimacy in the body of believers. # DISCIPLESHIP

We uphold the Great Commission of what Jesus told his disciples in Matthew 28:18-20, which is to “go and make disciples of all nations” by walking with them through life and equipping them with to walk in the Way of Jesus. We hold a strong conviction that discipleship must be present to build up believers and involves walking people through a process of becoming like Christ through teaching, accountability, and following Christ as he instructed us to be imitators of him. Discipleship involves first adherence to truth, and then a humility to die to oneself daily to follow Christ.

TRANSFORMATION OF SELF IN MATURITY IN WALK WITH CHRIST, THEN BUILDING UP LEADERS AND FAMILIES TO WALK WITH CHRIST USING PRACTICAL TOOLS BASED FIRMLY ON SCRIPTURE AND BIBLICAL TRUTH.

We aim to first experience transformation and growth in our own lives in our walk with Christ. Then, we live out discipleship through a methodological approach that equips people with tangible and actionable steps and tools to follow Jesus in their everyday lives and circumstances. Ultimately true, intentional discipleship leads to sanctification of the believer and transformation closer to Christ.
