Knowledge vs. Knowledge

Isaiah 61:4-7
(1984 NIV)

**4 They will rebuild the ancient ruins
and restore the places long devastated;
they will renew the ruined cities
that have been devastated for generations.**

**5 Aliens will shepherd your flocks;
foreigners will work your fields and vineyards.**

**6 And you will be called priests of the Lord,
you will be named ministers of our God.**

**You will feed on the wealth of nations,
and in their riches you will boast**

**7 Instead of their shame my people will receive a double portion,
and instead of disgrace they will rejoice in their inheritance;
and so they will inherit a double portion in their land,
and everlasting joy will be theirs.**

and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.**


**11 For as the soil makes the sprout come up and a garden causes seeds




SECURE



My relationship with God can feel intense and close one moment, then distant the next.


