1. Once again, the Lord commanded Moses to symbolically stretch out his hand toward heaven, and God brought forth the 9<sup>th</sup> miraculous plague- \_\_\_\_\_ so \_\_\_\_\_ it could be \_\_\_\_\_. (vv. 21-23a)

2. Pharaoh called for Moses and offered a compromise, since his livestock had been devastated, he wanted the Israelites to leave \_\_\_\_\_ of their \_\_\_\_\_ behind. Moses sternly \_\_\_\_\_ his offer. (vv. 24-26)

## K. Plague #10: Death of the Firstborn (11:1-12:36)

1. Moses' speech (11:4-8) was delivered between verses 26 and 27 of chapter 10, and it \_\_\_\_\_ with Moses leaving the palace in \_\_\_\_\_ (10:29; 11:8).
2. Moses was instructed to speak to the Israelites, they were to \_\_\_\_\_ the Egyptians whom they served for articles of \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ and costly materials (vv. 2-3a), and from 12:35-36 we know that this did take place.

3. By this time after 9 all-encompassing, cataclysmic plagues, Moses was considered a "\_\_\_\_\_" \_\_\_\_\_" in the eyes of the Israelites, Egyptians, and even Pharaoh's personal servants. (v. 3b, cf. Num. 12:3)
4. Before his departure (in 10:28-29) Moses described the 10<sup>th</sup> plague to Pharaoh in specific terms, in every \_\_\_\_\_ family the firstborn son would \_\_\_\_\_ around \_\_\_\_\_ from the poorest household to that of the royal court. (vv. 4-6)

\* Would anyone be exempt from this deadly plague? (v. 7)

5. Moses predicted that the mourning would be so grievous in the land, the Egyptians would actually \_\_\_\_\_ to him and \_\_\_\_\_ him to take the Israelites away with him; Moses then left Pharaoh. (v. 8)
