### II. ISRAEL'S REVELATION FROM GOD AT SINAI (Exodus 19-40)

#### A. The Sin of Israel (32:1-6)

1. Moses had been on Mount Sinai \_\_\_\_\_ days (24:18) receiving the rest of God's law (Ex. 25-31) with the details of the tabernacle when the people became \_\_\_\_\_. (v. 1)

\* What was the root cause of their sin?

#### B. The Intercession of Moses (32:7-14)
