# THE FIRST READING: Genesis 2:15-17, 3:1-7

The Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to till it and keep it. And the Lord God commanded the man, "You may freely eat of every tree of the garden, but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall die."

Now the serpent was more crafty than any other wild animal that the Lord God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God say, 'You shall not eat from any tree in the garden'?" The woman said to the serpent, "We may eat of the fruit of the trees in the garden, but God said, 'You shall not eat of the fruit of the tree that is in the middle of the garden, nor shall you touch it, or you shall die.' "But the serpent said to the woman, "You will not die, for God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food and that it was a delight to the eyes and that the tree was to be desired to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate, and she also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate. Then the eyes of both were opened, and they knew that they were naked, and they sewed fig leaves together and made loincloths for themselves.

# **THE PSALM: Psalm 32** (Read responsively by half verse.)

- <sup>1</sup> Happy are those whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.
- <sup>2</sup> Happy are those to whom the Lord imputes no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.
- <sup>3</sup> While I kept silence, my body wasted away through my groaning all day long.
- For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer.
- <sup>5</sup> Then I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not hide my iniquity;
- I said, 'I will confess my transgressions to the Lord', and you forgave the guilt of my sin.
- <sup>6</sup> Therefore let all who are faithful offer prayer to you;
- at a time of distress, the rush of mighty waters shall not reach them.
- You are a hiding-place for me; you preserve me from trouble;
  - you surround me with glad cries of deliverance.
- 8 I will instruct you and teach you the way you should go; I will counsel you with my eye upon you.
- Do not be like a horse or a mule, without understanding, whose temper must be curbed with bit and bridle, else it will not stay near you.
- Many are the torments of the wicked, but steadfast love surrounds those who trust in the Lord.
- <sup>11</sup> Be glad in the Lord and rejoice, O righteous, and shout for joy, all you upright in heart.

## THE SECOND READING: Romans 3:19-26

Now we know that, whatever the law says, it speaks to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be silenced and the whole world may be held accountable to God. For no human will be justified before him by deeds prescribed by the law, for through the law comes the knowledge of sin.

But now, apart from the law, the righteousness of God has been disclosed and is attested by the Law and the Prophets, the righteousness of God through the faith of Jesus Christ for all who believe. For there is no distinction, since all have sinned and

fall short of the glory of God; they are now justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God put forward as a sacrifice of atonement by his blood, effective through faith. He did this to demonstrate his righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over the sins previously committed; it was to demonstrate at the present time his own righteousness, so that he is righteous and he justifies the one who has the faith of Jesus.

## THE HOLY GOSPEL: Matthew 4:1-11
