Stop imitating the ideals and opinions of the culture around you, but be inwardly transformed by the Holy Spirit through a total reformation of how you think. This will empower you to discern God's will as you live a beautiful life, satisfying and perfect in his eyes.

- 1. If you don't know the people at your table, introduce yourself including your: name, city where you live, and a "10-second tell" about how you connected to River of Life.
- 2. What was your one take away from the teaching tonight?
- 3. Recalibrating our lives involves thinking about what we are thinking about. At some point everyone struggles with negative thoughts about themselves that do not line up with how God truly sees us. Are you able to identify some of the negative ideas you think about yourself?
 - What are they?
 - Do you know where these thoughts came from?
- 4. Our faulty beliefs (sometimes called mind-games) influence the way that we act. Therefore, we cannot simply change our behavior, we must first change how we think.
 - Can you, or the people at your table, think of truths from scripture that can help you renew your negative mind-games and bring them in line with what scripture says is true?
- 5. Which mind game will you choose to try and recalibrate this week to come into line with God's truth?
 - Sometimes it's overwhelming to try and change everything at once, so choose one thought that you would like to recalibrate, ask the Holy Spirit to make you aware of when you are thinking this and then choose to repeat the truth from God's word instead.
- 6. What is the most challenging part of taking every thought captive?
