1. Have you ever had children or been around children that were difficult to understand? How did it make you feel? (Whether we find this adorable or frustrating, this perspective can help us understand what we believe about God's opinion toward us and our prayer life.)
2. Being honest, on a scale of 1-10 where would you rate your prayer life and why?
 - What would you like to see different in your prayer life?
 - What is the main purpose of praying?
3. What do you think about the idea that God answers prayer in 4 different ways?
 - Which answer do you tend to have the most difficulty accepting?
 - (Yes, No, I will if you will, Wait)
4. Do you have an easier time engaging in conversation with God or with the enemy (worry, fear, what-ifs, justifications, etc.)
 - Think of your response, why is this conversation easier for you?
5. A Faith Confession is the way you speak about an issue to yourself and others. How often does your Faith Confession line up with your prayers?
 - Can you think of a situation in life where what you pray and what you say are in opposition to each other? What can you do this week to bring those into alignment?
6. What do you think of the concept— Pray What You Got?
 - How can this help you deepen your prayer life this week?
