MADE TO EXPLORE

an activity that extends learning through hands-on experimentation and discovery



Before kids arrive, take a few moments to pray for them. Pray for those who might visit your group for the first time. Pray that all of the kids would take to heart the truth that they were created by a creative God who has blessed each one of them with individual gifts and talents. Pray that God would lead the kids to discover what those gifts are and that He would give them opportunities to use those gifts to share His story.

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1. EARLY ARRIVER

WHAT YOU NEED: Offering container, salt, paper, magnifying glass or magnifying app

WHAT YOU DO:

- Show kids where they can place their offerings.
- Pour a little bit of each kind of salt onto white paper and invite kids to look at it, feel it, and examine it under magnification.
- Encourage kids to describe and compare what they see and feel.
- If they cleaned their hands, let kids taste small bits of salt.

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2. OPENING ACTIVITY

WHAT YOU NEED: "Ocean or Jungle" Activity Pages, "Ocean and Jungle Animals" Activity Pages, hula hoops

WHAT YOU DO:

- Set the hula hoops at opposite ends of your environment.
- Set an "Ocean or Jungle" card in each.
- Fan out the "Ocean and Jungle Animals" cards in your hand and invite a kid to pull one out.
- Lead kids to move like that animal to the place where that animal lives: ocean or jungle.
- Call kids back to you and play again.
- Continue as time remains or until all cards are played.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"Does an elephant belong in the ocean? Does a shark belong in the jungle? No! That would be SO silly! [Transition] In Large Group, we'll hear about something else that would be silly to keep in the wrong spot. Let's go learn more."

Lead your group to the Large Group area.

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1. SALT OF THE EARTH [TALK ABOUT GOD | BIBLE STORY REVIEW]

WHAT YOU NEED: Cardstock, white glue, table salt, baking dish or plastic container, liquid watercolor paint, brushes, wet wipes, cardboard

WHAT YOU DO:

- Explore what Jesus meant when He said, "You are the salt of the earth." You can use the conversation guide below for ideas.
- Prep kids for this activity by telling them they need to show self-control and patience as they make their creations. If necessary, during the activity, ask kids to "take a break" for a few moments if they aren't showing self-control.
- Give each kid a piece of cardstock and set out the glue.
 - Be sure the nozzles are opened just enough for the glue to flow freely, but not so much that it pours out.
- Invite kids to "draw" with the glue by squeezing it over their papers.
 - They can draw squiggles, hearts, rainbows, flowers, animals, whatever their creativity inspires!
- When each kid finishes, help them lay their creation in the container.
- Lead them to sprinkle the glue with salt until it's completely covered.
- Help them gently tip their paper to allow the excess salt to fall off.
- Guide them to put their artwork on a piece of cardboard.
- Set out the watercolors and brushes.
- Show kids how they can dip a brush into the watercolor then gently touch the brush to their salt-covered glue design.

HINT: Assign particular brushes to specific colors. Instruct kids to use one brush for each color of paint.

WHAT YOU SAY:

When kids add salt to their artwork: "When Jesus said that we are the salt of the earth, He meant that just like salt can make food taste better, we can make life better. We can make it better by spreading God's love to the people around us."

When kids add watercolor to their designs: "Wow! That's amazing! The salt soaked up the color and spread it! That reminds me of what Jesus said: You are the salt of the earth. Just like the salt soaked up the color, God wants us to soak up His love and spread it to the people around us. Because when we spread God's love, we share His story!

[Make it Personal] (Tell kids how you've creatively used something that you're good at to share God's story with others.)

"What's something that you're good at that you can use to share God's story with others? (I like to bake with my grandma. We can bake cookies and give them away. I can help the other kids on my team. I can draw a picture for my

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*2. SHARE HIS STORY [LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: No supplies needed

WHAT You Do:

- Play an application-packed game similar to "Mother May 12"
- Ask kids to tell what it means to share God's story (to tell others about God; to show others that God loves them; to share God's love with others).
- Invite them to name ways they could use the things they're good at to share God's story with others (make a card for someone who's sick; be kind to my teammates; invite my gymnastics friends to church).
- Next, guide kids to line up shoulder to shoulder at one end of the environment while you stand at the opposite end.
- Call out a kid's name and read a scenario below.
- Lead the kid to respond by saying one way they could share God's story in that situation. (If a kid is stuck, ask guiding questions to help. Help kids understand that part of sharing God's story is simply by showing God's love.)
- When the kid answers, say, "God created you to share His story! Move forward _____ (specify a type and number of steps)."

Note: Never force a shy kid to share aloud. They can whisper their idea to you or to a friend, or they can choose another kid to answer for them.

- The game ends when every kid reaches you.
 - A new kid joins your class. How could you share God's story?
 - A kid sits by himself at lunch. How could you share God's story?
 - Someone is mean to a girl on the playground. How could you share God's story?
 - Your neighbor is sick. How could you share God's story?
 - Your sister is crying. How could you share God's story?
 - Your friend falls and gets hurt. How could you share God's story?
 - Your church is collecting food for a food drive. How could you share God's story?
 - Your teacher looks really sad. How could you share God's story?
 - Your brother is upset. How could you share God's story?
 - A friend doesn't go to church. How could you share God's story?

Note: If you run out of scenarios, create your own or simply repeat the given scenarios—repetition is a great teacher!

WHAT YOU SAY:

"Jesus said, 'You are the light of the world.' That means that if you're a follower of Jesus, you're like a light that shines in the darkness. You shouldn't hide that light. Jesus said, 'Let your light shine so others can see it.' You can shine your light by (insert some of the kids' ideas from the game).

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3. LET YOUR LIGHT SHINE

[HEAR FROM GOD | MEMORY VERSE ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: Paper plates prepared with "Psalm 145:3 Cards" and "Number Cards" Activity Pages; Bible, tape, glow sticks and connectors, (optional) black light

WHAT YOU DO:

- Before kids join you, bend each glow stick into a loop and secure it with a connector.
- Invite a volunteer to open the Bible to Psalm 145:3. Read the verse aloud, guiding kids to repeat after you.
- Set the paper plates flat on the floor in an inverted triangle (bowling-pin style) with plate #1 at the tip.
- Set up one "rack" for every four kids.
- Secure the plates with tape, if necessary.
- Guide kids to line up about six feet from the plates.
- Hand the first kid a glow stick loop and give them three attempts to toss the loop so that it lands on the first paper plate.
- When it does, reveal the phrase and guide kids to say it after you.
- After a player successfully "rings" the first phrase, guide the next player to land the loop on the second plate.
- When it does, reveal the second phrase and guide kids to say the first two phrases.
- Continue until kids reveal the entire verse.
- Note: Adjust the distance the kids stand from the plates according to their skill levels.
- Optional: Add fun with a black light!

WHAT YOU SAY:

"If you're a follower of Jesus, when you show God's love to others and tell others how great He is, you shine your light to the world around you. And when you do that, Jesus said that people will 'bring glory to your Father who is in heaven.' That means that people will see how good God is, and they'll praise Him! So, shine your light and tell others how GREAT God is! Because God created you to share His story!"

"If you're a follower of Jesus, when you show God's love to others and tell others about Him, you shine your light to the world around you. You make life better by spreading His love. Let's pray and ask God to help us share His story."

Pray, asking God to help both you and the kids be creative and use the things that you're good at to share His story with others.

As adults arrive to pick up, give each kid a glow stick (if you provided them). Encourage kids to tell their families one way they can share God's story with others.

1. SALT OF THE EARTH

[TALK ABOUT GOD | BIBLE STORY REVIEW]

Made to Explore: an activity that extends learning through hands-on experimentation and discovery

WHAT YOU NEED:

• White cardstock, one full sheet for each kid

- White glue; ideally, one bottle for each kid (check to make sure that the nozzles work)
- Table salt; about one container for every ten kids
- Unbreakable baking dish or plastic container that's large enough to hold a sheet of paper
- Liquid watercolor paint poured into small cups.
 Provide three or four colors and ideally one cup of paint for every two kids.
- Round-tipped brushes, ideally one for each cup to keep the colors separated
- Scrap cardboard such as cereal boxes or old poster board; cut into at least 9" X 12" pieces; one for each kid
- Wet wipes

*2. SHARE HIS STORY [LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

Made to Play: an activity that encourages learning through following guidelines and/or working as a group

WHAT YOU NEED:

• No supplies needed

3. LET YOUR LIGHT SHINE [HEAR FROM GOD | MEMORY VERSE ACTIVITY]

Made to Play: an activity that encourages learning through following guidelines and/or working as a group

WHAT YOU NEED:

- Print the "Psalm 145:3 Cards" and cut apart; one set for every four kids.
- Print the "Number Cards" and cut apart; one set for every four kids.

HINT: Staple the "Psalm 145:3 Cards" and "Number Cards" together before you cut them. That way you can cut them apart at the same time.

- Paper plates; six for every four kids
 - Attach each "Psalm 145:3" card to a paper plate.
 - Cover each card with its corresponding "Number" card.
- Glow sticks with connectors, one for every four kids (If glow sticks aren't an option for your group, you can substitute yellow pom poms.)
- Tape or hook and loop tape if the plates are likely to slide on your floor

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1. EARLY ARRIVER IDEA

WHAT YOU NEED: Offering container, opaque cups, and electric votive

WHAT YOU DO:

- Invite kids to put their offering in the offering container as they arrive.
- Place three cups upside down on the table.
- Turn on the votive and place it under an opaque cup.
- Move the cups around, then let kids guess where the votive is. (Depending
 on the dynamic of your group, you can let kids guess all at once or have
 them take turns, with one kid being the guesser each round.)
- Think of creative ways to distract kids as you move the cups around, like exclaiming in a loud voice, "I didn't know Jojo Siwa (or other celebrity your kids like) went to church here!" while pointing behind the kids.

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2. OPENING ACTIVITY

WHAT YOU NEED: "Guess What Cards" Activity Pages, masking tape

WHAT YOU DO:

- One at a time, invite kids to the front of the group.
- Use a loop of masking tape to stick a card on their forehead.
- They must ask yes or no questions to the group to discover more about their secret object.
- At the end of ten questions, if they haven't guessed already, they must take a guess.
- Play until everyone who wants to participate has had a turn.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"All of these things had something in common. Can you guess? They either had to do with SALT or LIGHT. **[Transition]** Let's go hear more in Large Group!"

Lead your group to the Large Group area.

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*1. LIGHT THE WAY [TALK ABOUT GOD | BIBLE STORY REVIEW]

WHAT YOU NEED: Hula hoops, flashlights, five containers holding light sources, and Bibles

WHAT YOU DO:

Note: This is a room-wide activity with all Small Groups competing against each other. If you don't have more than one group, divide kids into two teams.

- Place a hula hoop, one for each team, around the perimeter of your environment.
- Assign each team a hula hoop.
- Instruct teams to form a line by their hula hoop and link arms.
- Teams will race to collect the five different light sources that will be scattered throughout the room.
 - Give the kid in the front of each line a flashlight.
 - The kid with the flashlight will light the way to direct their team to a container.
 - Once they reach a container, they pick up a light source from the container and return to their hula hoop to place it inside.
 - Each time the team returns to their hula hoop, a new kid gets the flashlight and becomes the leader.
 - Teams must always have arms linked before heading out to find another light source.
 - When everyone understands the game, turn off the lights, THEN randomly place the light source containers throughout the environment.
 - Say, "On your mark, get set, GO!"
 - The first team to retrieve all five light sources, wins.
- Tell teams to return to their Small Groups with their hula hoop and light sources for discussion and wrap-up.
- Read Matthew 5:14-16 to the group.
- Ask: What is the purpose of the lamp? So you can see things. In our game, what was the purpose of the flashlight? To help you find the containers and lead the way back to your hula hoop.
- To dig deeper, ask: Why do you think the Bible is a light source? This is an opportunity to teach that one way to know God's story is to read the Bible. The Bible shines light to show us how to love others like Jesus. Share how learning God's Word has helped you know God.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"Jesus says, 'You are the light of the world.' Just like the flashlight lit the way to help you see the containers and hula hoops, Jesus tells you to light the way to help others see Him. **God created you to share His story** and share Jesus' love with others. God wants you to talk about Him, and He wants your actions to honor Him and show others they are important to Him. When you invite

someone to church, you are sharing Jesus' story. When you respond kindly to someone who annoys you, you share Jesus' story by treating others the way you want to be treated. Every time you trust God, no matter what, you share His story by showing others how important God is to you and that trusting God is a wise choice."

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2. BE THE LIGHT [LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: "Light Game Tiles," "Lights Out Game Tiles," "Game Board" Activity Page, "Light Cards," "Start/ End Game Tiles," cardstock, and die

WHAT YOU DO:

WORSHIP

- Pair kids up into teams.
- Lay out the "Game Tiles" and cardstock on the floor as shown on the "Game Board" Activity Page.
- Line the teams up at the "Start Tile."
- With each turn, teams roll a die to determine how many spaces they can move together. Before teams can move forward along the "Game Board," they must say, "God created me to share His story."
- If a team lands on a space with a lit candle, they draw a "Light Card" and follow the instructions.
- If a team lands on a space with an extinguished candle, they roll the die again to see how many spaces they must move back.
- The first team to reach the "Good Job!" space, wins.
- If you run out of "Light Cards" before a winner is declared, shuffle the cards and reuse them.
- If time allows, play a couple of rounds.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"You are made in the image of God and **God created you to share His story.** When we let our light shine and treat others the way we want to be treated, we show them who Jesus is. Imagine you won a trip to Disney World®. You would be so excited that you would tell all your friends. We should be that excited to show Jesus' love to others. Jesus has done so much for us. He made a way for us to be with God, now and forever. That is really cool! We can share His story with our words and our actions. Every time we let our light shine and treat others the way we want to be treated we share God's story with the world."

WHAT YOU NEED: "Spinner Template" Activity Page, paper plates, markers, scissors, pennies, Bibles, and stickers (optional)

WHAT YOU DO:

- Look up Psalm 145:3 and read it together. See tips for looking up verses with 2nd and 3rd graders in Week One.
- Give each kid a paper plate and a "Spinner Template."
- Guide them to trace the "Spinner Template" on their paper plate and cut out the circle.
- Help kids fold the disc in half and cut a quarter-inch slit in the center.
- Tell kids to write the memory verse on the cut-out circle and decorate it with several different colors and the stickers (if provided).
- When they are finished, help kids put a penny in the slit in the center. It may take a bit of wiggling to secure the penny in the slit.
- On a hard surface, like a table or non-carpeted floor, challenge kids to spin the disc by spinning the penny.
- Challenge kids to say the entire verse before their "Verse Spinner" stops moving.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"Such creative Verse Spinners! You did a great job memorizing our verse this month! Let's say Psalm 145:3 together. 'Lord, you are great. You are really worthy of praise. No one can completely understand how great you are.' (NIrV) God IS great! And we should share His greatness with others. God created you to share His story, and share who He is." [Make It Personal] (Share with the group who first told you about God's story. Maybe it was your parents when they taught you how to pray. Maybe your grandparents would read a chapter of the Bible to you when you visited. Maybe a friend invited you to church.)

1. JUST FOR FUN

WHAT YOU NEED: Offering container, salt, paper plates

WHAT YOU DO:

- Invite kids to place their offerings in the container.
- Give partners a plate containing a thin layer of salt.
- **Direct** them to use their fingers as pens and draw a grid in the salt by making four lines down and four lines across.
- Let one partner choose to draw X's and the other O's then play Tic-Tac-Toe.
 - The "X" player goes first then the partners alternate placing "X"s and "O"s inside the squares of the grid until a row is completed horizontally, vertically, or diagonally.
 - If all 16 squares are filled and neither player has four in a row, the game is a draw.
- **Switch** partners and repeat.

2. OPENING ACTIVITY

WHAT YOU NEED: Aluminum foil, flashlight

WHAT YOU DO:

- **Separate** into teams of three or four kids (boys with boys; girls with girls).
- **Give** each team a roll of foil.
- **Tell** everyone they have five minutes to wrap one of their teammates from head to toe (not face) in foil until they "shine."
- Gather kids back together when groups are finished.
- **Shine** a flashlight on each foil-covered teammate to see if one shines more brightly than the other.
 - If you have access to a darkened room, that'd be the perfect place to test their shine.
- Remove the foil and place in a recycling bin.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"There's no hiding the light that shines off of our foil friends. God wants us all to shine—but thankfully He doesn't ask us to wear aluminum foil to do it! [Transition] Let's go to Large Group to hear what He has called us to do and how we can use our creativity to do it!"

1. TAKE A SNAPSHOT [TALK ABOUT GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: No supplies needed

WHAT YOU DO:

- **Invite** kids to take turns sharing funny stories of stuff they did as little kids.
- What are some favorite memories they have (or have been told) from when they were younger?
- If your group is big enough, divide kids into groups of three and let them spend a few minutes sharing stories.
- Then gather kids back all together.
- Guide them to take turns telling the story of someone else who was in their group of three and let the rest of the group try to guess which person the story is about.
- Include memories they have of learning about God.
 - Who helped them first learn about Jesus?
 - What Bible stories do they recall from earlier years?
 - Did they have favorite Children's Ministry person or Small Group Leader?

WRAP UP AND SAY:

"If you heard about Jesus as a little kid or just recently, it's because someone knew that God's story was worth sharing with you. It may have been a friend, parent, church leader, family member, or someone who wrote a book you read or spoke at a camp you visited. No matter who it was, God used them to shine the light of His love into your heart and help you understand who Jesus is and what He's done for you. You can do that, too. If you know and follow Jesus, He will help you use your gifts and talents in creative ways to share the most important story anyone will ever hear—the story of how God sent His Son, Jesus, to rescue us."

2. BIBLE STORY EXTENSION [TALK ABOUT GOD | BIBLE STORY REVIEW]

WHAT YOU NEED: "Lightbulb" Activity Page, salt, squeeze bottles of white glue, liquid watercolors, cookie sheets, paintbrushes, table covering

WHAT YOU DO:

- Cover the work area with a plastic table cloth.
- **Set out** the water colors and brushes within reach of the teams
- Form groups of three kids.

Note: If you have enough supplies and a manageable amount of kids, let each kid make his or her own salty lightbulb painting.

- **Give** each group a copy of the "Lightbulb" Activity Page, a cookie sheet, and a bottle of glue.
- **Direct** teams to use the glue to trace a thick line over the outline of the lightbulb.
- **Tell** kids to sprinkle the glued area with salt until it is thoroughly covered.
- Tip the cardstock gently to let extra salt fall onto the cookie sheet.
- **Show** kids how to dip the paint brush into the liquid water color then gently touch the brush to the salt-covered glue lines in several places.
 - The paint will begin to travel in both directions along the line of glue and salt.
 - Repeat with each color.
 - After kids have observed the colors moving and blending together, set all of the paintings aside to dry.
 - Dry time could be up to two days, so make sure kids and families are aware of this as they leave today.
- **Ask** for a volunteer to look up today's Bible story and read it aloud. (Matthew 5:14-16).
- **Discuss** some ways the salt experiment is an illustration of sharing God's story with others.
 - In what ways are Jesus followers like salt?
 - How are they like light?
 - If each grain of salt represented a person who needs to hear God's story, how is this experiment an illustration of the following statement: "God created you to share His story."
 - When you think of spreading the story of Jesus by sharing it with others, what are some ways you see yourself able to do that?
 - We talk to others about the things that are important to us. Why do we sometimes have a hard time talking about God or our church?
- Challenge your group to think about ways they can be salt and light.
 - Who do you know that needs to hear God's story?
 - Given the opportunity, how would you show someone what it looks like to be a follower of Jesus? What would you tell them?
- **Encourage** everyone to look for creative ways to use their gifts to shine for Jesus this week.
