**February 25th - March 25th**

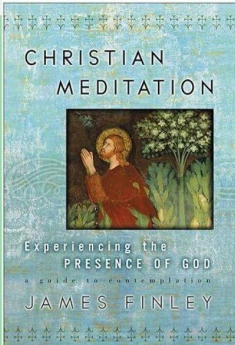

There will also be a 10 AM Sunday morning study group for the John Ortberg book. Use the QR code here to sign up!

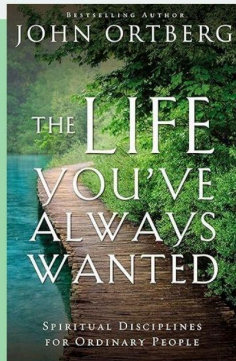

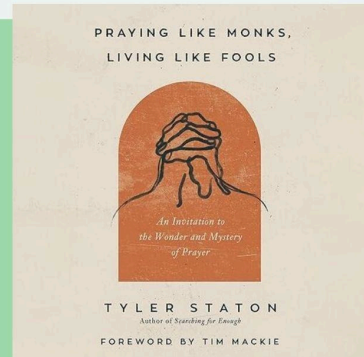
