## THE KING ANOINTED

- The Lord chose S\_\_\_\_\_ to be a ruler over God's people.
- By allowing Saul to rule the people, God did not give up his authority. He is still the K\_\_\_\_\_ of Kings!
- In Genesis, Adam and Eve were allowed to rule over God's creation, but they still had to submit to God's authority (obey God).
- Sin is rejecting God's authority.

## THE KING ASSURED

- These signs show that Saul should:
  - Trust God's providence (wisdom and guidance)
  - Trust God's provision (providing for our needs)
  - Trust God's power (might and strength)
- God's presence was all Saul needed to depend on (v. 7)

## THE KING ANNOUNCED

- When it came time to announce Saul as king, Saul was missing! He was found hiding in the B\_\_\_\_\_ (10:22).
- The people shouted, "Long live the king!" but some worthless men asked, "Can this man save us?"
- These men were doubting God's plan and direction.
- But, the answer is... no. Saul and all the kings after him would fail in some big ways.
- There is only one King who can save us: King J\_\_\_\_\_


