Take time and identify the steps that brought you to the point of you giving your life to Christ? Where were you? What was happening at the time?
  - ✓ \_\_\_\_\_: How has your life in Christ made a difference? How has forgiveness impacted you? How have your thoughts, emotions, attitudes, changed? What does your relationship with Christ mean to you now?
