



Lesson 22: He's Here! (Luke 1-2)

Big Idea: The Old Testament points to God's great plan to rescue his people. God will provide the rescuer - Jesus

From the story we learned about how God the Father finally fulfilled his promise to rescue man by sending his son Jesus to be born in Bethlehem.

Please help your child to memorize the verse and the Scripture reference. Please review with them the Gospels and teach them about the New Testament.

Scripture Memory Verse:

Luke 2:11 - Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord.

Discussion Questions:

1. Joseph was related to who? "David"
2. What was the angel's name? "Gabriel"
3. Was Mary excited to see Gabriel? "No she was scared"
4. What did Gabriel tell Mary? "She will have a baby boy and his name will be Jesus."
5. Where was Jesus born? "In a stable in the city of Bethlehem."

Catechism Question:

Question 11: What does God require in the sixth, seventh, and eighth commandments?

Answer 11: Sixth, that we do not hurt or hate our neighbor. Seventh, that we live purely and faithfully. Eighth, that we do not take without permission that which belongs to someone else.
