



Lesson 7: The Present (Gen 22)

Big Idea: Abraham was asked to give up his only son, Isaac. But God provided a sacrifice in Isaac's place.

From the story we learned that God kept his promises to Abraham. Even though Abraham did not understand God's instructions, he had faith in God.

Please help your child to memorize the verse and the Scripture reference. Please review with them the place of the book of Genesis in the Bible.

Scripture Memory Verse:

Genesis 16:6 - Abraham believed the Lord.

Discussion Questions:

1. Abraham was willing to give God his only son whom he loved, why? "Abraham trusted God and loved God more than anything."
2. What did God provide for the sacrifice instead of Isaac? "A ram."
3. Did Abraham understand why God wanted him to sacrifice his only son? "No, but he trusted God as his father who loved him."

Catechism Question:

Question 27: Are all people, just as they were lost through Adam, saved through Christ?

Answer 27: No. Only those who are elected by God and united to Christ by faith.
