



Lesson 4: A New Beginning (Gen 6-9)

Big Idea: God rescued Noah and his family because of his grace, not their goodness.

From the story we learned that Noah was chosen by God to be rescued because of His grace and not Noah's goodness. We too are saved because of God's grace.

Please help your child to memorize the verse and the Scripture reference. Please review with them the place of the book of Genesis in the Bible.

Scripture Memory Verse:

Genesis 6:5 - The Lord saw that the human heart was only evil

Discussion Questions:

1. How and why were Noah and his family rescued? "By God. He chose them"
2. What does God promise Noah? "That God would never again send a flood to destroy the world"
3. How many days and nights did it rain? "40 days and 40 nights"
4. What was the sign of the promise that God made to Noah? "God hung his rainbow in the sky"

Catechism Question:

Question 25: Does Christ's death mean all our sins can be forgiven?

Answer 25: Yes, because Christ's death on the cross fully paid the penalty for our sin, God will remember our sins no more.
