



Lesson 37: The Servant King (Mk 14, Jn 13-14)

Big Idea: Jesus is the Servant King whose body is broken and whose blood is poured out for us on the cross.

From the story we learned about the Last Supper and Judas' betrayal.

Please help your child to memorize the verse and the Scripture reference. Please review with them the Gospels and teach them about the New Testament.

Scripture Memory Verse:

Mark 8:31 - The Son of Man must be killed and after three days rise again.

Discussion Questions:

1. What is Passover? "The time when God's people remembered how God had rescued them from being slaves in Egypt."
2. What were Jesus' friends arguing about? "Stinky feet"
3. What did Jesus do? "He washed the feet of his friends"
4. Who left the upstairs room to do something bad? "Judas"
5. The bread is like what? "Jesus' body"
6. The wine is like what? "Jesus' blood"
7. What did Jesus tell them to do when they ate the bread and drank the wine?
"Remember that He rescued them"

Catechism Question:

Question 18: Will God allow our disobedience and idolatry to go unpunished?

Answer 18: No, God is righteously angry with our sins and will punish them both in this life, and in the life to come.
