


WHAT IS GOD TRYING TO ILLUSTRATE WITH HIS WORD?

When we grow increasingly lax in our pursuit of Bible literacy, everyone in our circle of influence is affected. Rather than acting as salt and light, we become bland contributions to the environment we inhabit and shape, indistinguishable from those who have never been changed by the gospel. Home, church, community, and country desperately need the influence of those who know why they believe what they believe, grounded in the Word of God. They desperately need the influence of believers who love deeply and actively the God proclaimed in the Bible.



Interpretation refers to understanding the meaning or big idea of the passage. Resources that can be beneficial to this step are Bible dictionaries and commentaries.

## Ask questions such as:

- Why did God include this in His Word?
- Why did the author write this?
- What is the historical and cultural context of this passage?
- What is true about God and His character?
- What sinful, broken or fallen condition is being addressed or corrected by this passage?

   How are people putting their trust in something apart from God?
- What are the universal principles, beliefs and values that can be taken from this passage?

Look through the lens of relationship. The God of Abraham, Jeremiah & Paul wants to speak to your heart every day.

Try to understand where your text fits into the Big Story of the Bible. What part does it play in telling the story of creation-fall-redemption-restoration? How does it point to the reign and rule of God?
