WISDOM (Intellectually)

Teach them to fear God.

The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding. — **Proverbs 9:10 (NKJV)**

Fear - a healthy respect and worshipful <u>reverence</u> for God. Be in awe of God.

Accept the Bible as the manual for living.

62% of Millennials (born 1981-1996) have never read the Bible.

STATURE (Maturity)

Maturity is more than physical growth.

Stature (helikia)

- Adultness, maturity of life, mind, and age
- One of the marks of maturity is knowing what gets your time, what affects your life.

Direct (train) your children onto the right path, and when they are older, they will not leave it. — **Proverbs 22:6 (NLT)**

Instructions are words. Training is <u>action</u>.

Training began at birth for the Hebrews. Midwives, who helped the Hebrew women with their children, would place a paste-like food on the roof of the child's mouth. This would stimulate their appetite. The baby would begin salivating, which prepared the child for nursing. It was all very intentional.

Create the right <u>craving</u>.

Innate temperament - "right path."

FAVOR WITH MAN (Socially)

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others. — Phillipians 2:3

Others before self.

Honesty & Honor

The sacrifice you desire is a broken spirit. You will not reject a broken and repentant heart, O God. — Psalm 51:17

Honor - Give value to people and things (everything). Feel the weight of how you treat them.

FAVOR WITH GOD (Spiritually)

Make Jesus the Lord of the home.

Lord - Ruler over all things.
