"The Gospel of Salvation" January 7, 2024

Romans 3

- 1. Greg said that the whole Bible is summed up in Romans 3:23-24. Read those verses together. Think about if you agree with Greg. Specifically consider: How might those verses sum up the story arc of scripture? Do they miss anything?
- **2. Greg spent time defining two important words: righteousness and propitiation.** As a group, define those words as best as you can, starting with righteousness.
- 3. Jesus called the pharisees "whitewashed tombs" they look good on the outside but are full of rot. As a culture, we talk a lot about hypocrisy. We like to point the finger at those who fail to live according to their own standards. Yet, Jesus invites us to think about our own hypocrisy. In what ways might Jesus' words convict you? Do you ever see areas of your life in which you are a "whitewashed tomb"?

Prayer Prompt: Who do you know who hasn't believed the gospel? Open the floor for sharing. After each person shares a name, have another person in the group claim that name; then end in prayer for each person. (On a practical note, you can 1) do popcorn prayer, or 2) pray in a circle; start with one person and then go clockwise around the circle. If some members of the group didn't claim a name to pray for, they can be passed over.)
